





Brightspace


Student Transportation: Little Elk Island Adventure

Typical Kindergarten Day

- Bell schedule- Kindergarten will start at 8:30 and end at 3:05.
- Early dismissal days- On the first Wednesday of each month students are dismissed one hour early. You will get reminder automated phone-calls the day before.
- Parent drop off and pick up- The classroom teacher will greet the students and walk them into the school each morning. At the end of the day, the teacher will dismiss the children one at a time, once ensuring an adult is present to pick up the child. The location of the entrance doors will be confirmed in September. If your child is riding the bus, a staff member will greet the children and walk them to the class line-up. At the end of the day, a staff member will escort bus students to their bus.





Typical Kindergarten Day

Staggered Entry

Small groups of students will attend during the first week in order to facilitate a successful transition to kindergarten. Your child's times for the staggered entry will be shared by your student's teacher.





Early Years Evaluation – Teacher Assessment (EYE-TA)

- Administered in the fall
- Uses teachers' regular observations and informal assessments
- Helps determine a child's progress and development in five key areas
 - Awareness of self and environment;
 - Social skills and approaches to learning;
 - Cognitive skills;
 - Language and communication; and
 - Physical development
- Assessment findings used to help plan instruction
