Student Transportation: 2022-23 registration is now open!

Planning to use Student Transportation in the 2022-23 school year? If so, make sure your child is registered so Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) can plan routes and send your child a bus pass before the first day of school. Families registered will receive tentative route schedules and invoices by the end of the month—fees are due June 30, 2022.
